

Required Tools: (Not included)

- A. Phillips screwdriver
- B. Flathead screwdriver
- C. 3 mm Allen wrench

⚠ WARNING

⚠ CAUTION: To avoid potential shock or other injury, turn power switch OFF and disconnect charger before conducting any assembly or maintenance procedures. Failure to follow these steps in the correct order may cause irreparable damage.

Step 1

Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove the four (4) screws from the side of the battery cover with the power switch.

**Step 2**

Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove the six (6) screws from the side of the battery cover with the charger port. Pull the battery cover apart being careful not to damage the wires inside. Set battery cover aside.



Step 3

Locate and disconnect the brake lever connector from the controller.



Step 4

Using a 3 mm Allen wrench, loosen the set screw on the throttle and move the throttle away from the grip.



Step 5

Using a flathead screwdriver, insert the blade in between the handlebar and grip and apply WD-40 or a few drops of soapy water. This will allow you to remove the grip and throttle from the handlebar.



Step 6

Reverse the procedures to install the new throttle.

ATTENTION: Charge battery 12 hours before using.
