

Required Tool: (Not included)

Phillips screwdriver

⚠ WARNING

⚠ CAUTION: To avoid potential shock or other injury, turn power switch OFF and disconnect charger before conducting any assembly or maintenance procedures. Failure to follow these steps in the correct order may cause irreparable damage.

Step 1

Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove six (6) screws located on the back of the battery cover.

**Step 2**

Lift the cover with the power switch and move aside (be careful not to pull the wires connected to the power switch). Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove one (1) screw from the battery bracket.



Step 3

Remove the battery cover from the opposite side and locate and disconnect the battery from controller.



Step 4

Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove one (1) screw from the battery bracket (remember the orientation of the battery when reinstalling the new battery).



Step 5

To install a new battery, reverse steps 1-4.

- Place the new battery in place and secure it with the screws.
- Reconnect the battery to the controller.
- Place the battery cover back in place.
- Reattach battery cover screws.

ATTENTION: Charge battery 12 hours before using.
