
- A. Phillips screwdriver
- B. Flathead screwdriver
- C. 5 mm Allen wrench

M WARNING

A CAUTION: To avoid potential shock or other injury, turn power switch <u>OFF</u> and disconnect charger before conducting any assembly or maintenance procedures. Failure to follow these steps in the correct order may cause irreparable damage.

Step 1

Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove the five (5) screws that hold the chain guard in place. Remove the chain guard and set it aside.



Step 2

Using a flathead screwdriver, remove the spring from the tension arm.



Step 3

Flip the unit on its side. Using a 5 mm Allen wrench, remove the two (2) hex bolts that hold the tensioner onto the frame and remove it.



Step 4

Replace the old tensioner with a new one.



Step 5

Reverse the steps to install the new chain tensioner.

ATTENTION: Charge battery 12 hours before using.
