

Required Tools: (Not included)

- Phillips screwdriver
 - Prillips screwariver
- Flathead screwdriver
- 19 mm wrench
- Small pointy object

WARNING

A CAUTION: To avoid potential shock or other injury, turn power switch <u>OFF</u> and disconnect charger before conducting any assembly or maintenance procedures. Failure to follow these steps in the correct order may cause irreparable damage.

Step 1

Using a Phillips screwdriver, loosen and remove seven (7) screws from the battery cover on the side with the charger port.



Step 2

Pull the battery cover off and set aside.



Step 3

Locate and disconnect the charger port from the controller.



Step 4

Using a small pointy object, depress the locking pins on the prongs and push them out of the connector.



Step 5

Using a flat screwdriver, remove the glue from the back of the charger port.



Step 6

Using a 19 mm wrench, loosen and remove the lock nut on the back of the charger port.



Step 7

Install the new charger port, then reverse steps 1 through 6.

ATTENTION: Charge battery 12 hours before using.
