## Required Tool: (Not included)

- Phillips screwdriver
- Flathead screwdriver
- Two (2) open wrenches


#### Step 1

Using a Philips screwdriver, remove the three (3) screws on the chain guard. Remove the chain guard.




#### Step 2

With a flat screwdriver, remove the spring from the tensioner arm.



## Step 3

Using two (2) 10 mm open wrenches, loosen and remove the nut and bolt that hold the tensioner onto the frame.



## Step 4

Replace the chain tensioner with the new one.



## Step 5

The tensioner needs to be positioned so that it is pushing upwards towards the lower side of the chain.



# Step 6

The chain tensioner is self-adjusting, so there is no need for adjustment.



# Step 7

Install the new chain tensioner, then reverse steps 1 through 6.

\* Place the chain guard back and secure it with screws.

ATTENTION: Charge battery 12 hours before using.
